This group experience will feature a tour of an active Kosher bakery as well as a discussion led by a trained docent facilitator in food, food-ways, and cultural experiences and traditions. Could precede or follow a tour of the Museum and/or synagogue. Includes water and a homemade cookie for each person in the group!

Groups can bring their own Glatt Kosher beverage if desired.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

How many people can you accommodate inside the bakery?

The bakery can accommodate up to 40 people.

Could my group bring in any food or drinks?

Yes, but the food and drink MUST be Glatt Kosher or Pareve.

What ingredients does the bakery use that I/my group may be allergic to? Does the bakery have any substitutes should someone not be able to eat the products?

The baked items may contain soy, nuts, eggs, soy bean oil, or non-dairy creamer. No dairy is used in making any product. With advanced notice of one week, fruit can be provided for those who have allergies to these products.

Does my group pay only for the actual number of people who visit or would you expect to be paid for the number of people that signed up initially?

The group pays only for who is present on the day of the visit.
