Through curricula for schoolchildren, K through 12, family activities, adult courses, specialized tours and website-based programs, the Museum seeks to fulfill its educational mission to involve individuals of all ages and backgrounds, locally and throughout the United States.

Responsibilities Include:

Write tour outlines, curricula, pre- and post-visit activities and lesson plans in accord with school district and State standards

Speak to teachers in advance of visits

Train docents to handle gallery-based activity

Observe school visits and lead evaluations to hone the curricula and docent performances

Formulate and implement events for teachers and professional development

Develop website resources for teachers

Plan appropriate continuing education for docents

Assist in planning and implementation of monthly docent meetings

Assist in planning and implementation of adult courses

Lead tours when required
