



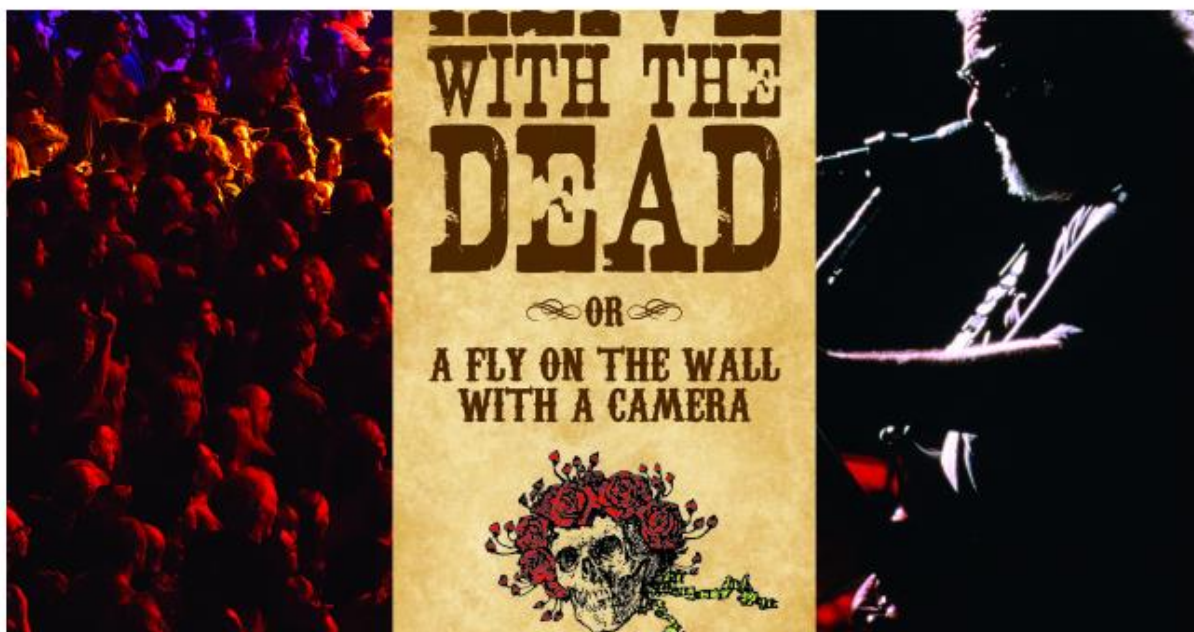
Hear Stories from the Backstages of Grateful Dead Tours
